**Call to Order**

Mayor Mixon called the meeting to order at 5:30pm

**Pledge of Allegiance**

Mayor Mixon called for the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Roll Call**

Present were Mayor Mixon, Mayor Pro-tem Peterson, Councilor Billingsley, Councilor Trom, Councilor Jassmann. Also, present were Manager Mitchell and Village Clerk Terry Cordova. A quorum was present.

**Approval of Agenda**

Councilor Jassmann made the motion to approve the agenda. Councilor Trom seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

**Approval of the Consent Agenda**

**1. Approval of the December 22<sup>nd</sup> Regular Council Meeting Minutes**

Councilor Billingsley made the motion to approve the consent agenda. Councilor Jassmann seconded .Motion carried 4-0

**Request and Responses from the Audience (Limited to 3 minutes)-None**

**Announcements and Proclamations –None**

**Reports**

**1. Governing Body Report**

Mayor Mixon announced that she will be making a few changes to our village committees. The following changes will as follows, Councilor Jassmann will now be the liaison for the solid waste committee and the economic development. Councilor Billingsley is now the liaison for the fire adapted community committee and Mayor Pro-tem Peterson will be the liaison for the lodgers committee. I will be looking into changes in the pedestrian trails committee. The rest of the committee council liaisons will remain the same.

**Manager’s Report**

Manager Mitchell reported that village offices are still closed to the public and we have done well getting folks in and make appointments. We are handling most planning and zoning by appointment. I wanted to let the audience out there know that it’s fairly easy to make an appointment. We are making some changes to several positions in finance and reassigning of duties. If you have something and we have changed those duties we will make sure that you meet with the right person. Manager Mitchell also reported that unfortunately, after checking into the possibility to get our community center open we have come to the conclusion after checking with the Governor’s office that we cannot do it at this time because of the public health orders or until those orders are rescinded.

**2. Committee Report-None**

**Old Business:**

**A. Discussion/ Approval of an Ordinance Amending Title Nine (9) of Village Code, Establishing the R-7 Single –Family Village Home District Zoning (2nd Reading) (Public Hearing)**

Mayor Mixon opened the public hearing at 5:45pm. Manager Mitchell explained that we fully discussed this at the last council meeting, and once again, it is something that was presented to planning and zoning. We saw a gap in the village zoning areas for this type of

1 subdivision or housing. This allows for living quarters commonly called mother-in-law  
2 quarters or just spare quarters, detached garage or detached home offices. This was massaged  
3 out through planning and zoning and they had a unanimous recommendation for approval.  
4 With no further input Mayor Mixon closed the public hearing at 5:46pm. Councilor Trom  
5 made the motion to approve an ordinance amending title nine of the village code establishing  
6 the R-7 single –family village home district zoning. Councilor Billingsley seconded. With no  
7 further discussion the motion carried 4-0 with Mayor Pro-tem Peterson –aye, Councilor  
8 Billingsley –aye, Councilor Trom-aye, Councilor Jassmann-aye.

9 **B. Discussion/ Approval of an Ordinance Amending Ordinance 2019-01 Authorizing the**  
10 **Village of Angel Fire to Enter into an Agreement with the New Mexico Environment**  
11 **Department Clean Water State Revolving Fund (2nd Reading) (Public Hearing)**

12 Mayor Mixon opened the public hearing at 5:48. Sandy Garcia, Grants and Projects  
13 explained, this is the second reading for this amendment ordinance. There have been no  
14 changes since the last reading. We are asking for approval of this ordinance to continue with  
15 the agreement. With no further input Mayor Mixon closed the public hearing at 5:49pm.  
16 Councilor Billingsley made the motion to approve an ordinance amending ordinance 2019 -  
17 01 authorizing the Village of Angel Fire to enter into an agreement with the New Mexico  
18 Environmental Department Clean Water State Revolving Fund. Councilor Jassmann  
19 seconded. With no further discussion the motion carried 4-0 with Mayor Pro-tem Peterson –  
20 aye, Councilor Billingsley –aye, Councilor Trom- aye, Councilor Jassmann-aye.

21 **New Business:**

22 **A. Discussion/Approval of Resolution 2021-01 a Resolution Establishing the Open Meeting**  
23 **Resolution and Rescinding All Others**

24 Councilor Billingsley made the motion to approve of resolution 2021-01 a resolution  
25 establishing the open meeting act resolution and rescinding all others. Mayor Pro-tem  
26 Peterson seconded. Terry Cordova, Village Clerk explained that each year the council is  
27 required to establish the open meetings resolution. This item fulfills that requirement. The  
28 only change made to this resolution is found on page two, lines 15 through 19. In view of  
29 everything that happened in 2020 with COVID municipalities have been tasked to do their  
30 meetings virtually. Most of these resolutions did not cover the use of virtual devices to  
31 conduct their meetings. This resolution adds that option should we need it in case of  
32 emergencies. With no discussion the motion carried 4-0 with Mayor Pro-tem Peterson –aye,  
33 Councilor Billingsley –aye, Councilor Trom-aye, Councilor Jassmann-aye.

34 **B. Discussion/ Approval of Resolution 2021-02 a Resolution Approving Budget Adjustment**  
35 **for Fiscal Year 2020-2021**

36 Councilor Trom made the motion to approve resolution 2021-02 a resolution approving  
37 budget adjustments for fiscal year 2020-2021. Mayor Pro-tem Peterson seconded. Molli  
38 Grove, Finance Director explained that this resolution came about while Michael Steininger  
39 with DFA was preparing for our first quarter submittal to the state. We found that the state  
40 approved budget was not in alignment with the council approved budget. This resolution is  
41 for four (4) of the five (5) budget transfers and will align the two systems, the state and our  
42 system Caselle. The fifth budget adjustment is a repeat of one we discussed back in October  
43 concerning the Wildland Fire fund. There was an error in what was submitted and the final  
44 budget that was submitted to council and the state. This has been previously approved by  
45 council. Mayor Pro-tem Peterson asked if Molli could elaborate a little on the GO Bond  
46 adjustment. Molli Stated that the GO Bond revenue goes into the 101 general fund and then  
47 needs to be transferred into the 401 fund and we pay out of that fund. Those two numbers  
48 have to match, currently they are slightly off so we need to make that adjustment. With no  
49 further discussion the motion carried 4-0 with Mayor Pro-tem Peterson –aye, Councilor  
50 Billingsley-aye, Councilor Trom-aye, Councilor Jassmann-aye.

1           **C. Discussion/ Approval of Amendment #1 of Interim Loan Agreement and Promissory**  
2           **Note Authorizing the Village of Angel Fire to Reduce the Interest Rate of the New**  
3           **Mexico Environment Department Clean Water State Revolving Fund Loan #CWSRF**  
4           **086**

5           Councilor Trom made the motion to approve an amendment #1 of interim loan agreement and  
6           promissory note authorizing the Village of Angel Fire to reduce the interest rate of the New  
7           Mexico Environment Department Clean Water State Revolving Fund loan CWSRF 086.  
8           Councilor Billingsley seconded. Amos Torres, Public Utilities Superintendent explained that  
9           this is in regards to the ordinance that was passed earlier. The purpose for this loan/grant is  
10          the required upgrades to the wastewater treatment plant. NMED has agreed to decrease the  
11          interest amount on the loan from 3.00% to 0.50% under the same terms and conditions set  
12          forth in the original agreement. Mayor Pro-tem Peterson asked if there was a 20 year payback  
13          AMP. Amos said yes he believed there was. With no further discussion the motion carried 4-  
14          0.

15          **D. Discussion/Approval of Task Order #2018-013C with HDR Engineering for the Potable**  
16          **Water Storage Tanks 2 and 4 Leak Repair**

17          Mayor Pro-tem Peterson made the motion to approve task order 2018-013C with HDR  
18          Engineering for the potable water storage tanks 2 and 4 leak repair. Councilor Billingsley  
19          seconded. Amos Torres, Public Utilities Superintendent explained we have two tanks that are  
20          in need of repair and we contracted with HDR engineering. We did put this project out to bid,  
21          we have several issues with the bidding process. So we decided to wait until spring. So this  
22          task order is for HDR engineering to come up with the bid documents and get it out again to  
23          get this project going in the spring. The funding that we have is set to expire here shortly so  
24          we do need to use this funding. We have special appropriation funding and I believe that we  
25          have approximately \$115,000 to start this project with and I also have some funding in the  
26          public utilities budget if we need it. With no discussion the motion carried 4-0

27          **E. Discussion/Approval of Task Order # 2020-06 with Dennis Engineering for the Design of**  
28          **Tank #7**

29          Councilor Billingsley made the motion to approve of task order 2020-06 with Dennis  
30          Engineering for the design of tank #7. Mayor Pro-tem Peterson seconded. Amos Torres,  
31          Public Utilities Superintendent explained after evaluation of Potable Water Tank #7 by  
32          Dennis Engineering Company it was recommended that this tank be replaced instead of  
33          repaired. This water tank is located on Cheerful Way. We will use special appropriation  
34          funding in the amount of \$ 158,000. The task order in the amount of \$146,280 plus NMGR, T,  
35          so there is a saving there. Manager Mitchell added that originally when it was Angel Fire  
36          Services, the previous owner was the resort and they were running the water department. It  
37          was eventually deeded over to the Village. They only gave a small portion of the land right  
38          around the tank. The resort thought we had a larger piece of the track, but when we  
39          researched that, we showed them that we have a very small piece. I worked with the engineer  
40          on what they need to construct the new tank while the old one will also be in service and  
41          much more land was needed to put those larger tanks on. I have spoken with the resort and  
42          they are very amenable to doing this. They understand that this is good for the community  
43          and we are working with them on the new plot documents and to be able to get that land as  
44          public property. Councilor Trom asked if this would be coming before Council to accept this  
45          change to the property. Manager Mitchell stated yes it would as either a quick claim deed or  
46          something of that nature and be approved by Council to be part of the public property  
47          inventory. With no further discussion the motion carried 4-0
