Julie Kulhan showed us the grant request she is turning in today. We are requesting money for plants for the median which the Angel Fire Garden Club will plant. Money for the Community Center's bulb 8x2 garden and tools for the youth. We need to have 2 youth interns (14-25) for the Youth Empower that would be paid through this grant. It would be around \$15.00 an hour for a maximum of 40 hours. Also put in the grant for 3 signs to use in the gardens. Julie said that some Village employees have youths that might want to be in this program.

Grant request includes Trash bags, bottles, outside water fountain with a doggie station, 6X8 tough shed for the tool library with pegboard, a Pet station and benche. Suggested to not have bottles and Jo Mixon thought that visors would be a great addition. The tool library would be used for the entire community and Susan talked about having the tools identified somehow like painting them.

Talked about having a Beautification Award for a business. Too late for us to do that this year, so Jo Mixon was going to check if the Chamber board wanted to do it this year.

Susan asked if we could grant money to paint murals and use the youth and maybe
