WHEREAS, the State Per Diem and Mileage Act authorizes municipalities to adopt, by resolution, regulations relating to the Per diem and Mileage Act; and

WHEREAS, at the last Legislative Session in 2021 the per diem rates were changed;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the governing body of the Village of Angel Fire, meeting this 28th day of September 2021, adopt the State Per Diem Rates, as attached
