

**VILLAGE OF ANGEL FIRE
RESOLUTION NO 2022-53**

A RESOLUTION regarding the reimbursement of actual expenses related to a wildland firefighting response.

WHEREAS; the Village of Angel Fire has a Fire Department comprised of volunteer and career professional firefighters, and the Fire Department has a seasonal Wildland Firefighting Team; and

WHEREAS; the Wildland Team can be activated at any time of day or day of week, to respond to fires and incidents both in state as well as out of state with a minimum deployment of 14 days and

WHEREAS; the Wildland Team may be required to pay for certain items during their deployment and in the recent deployments a Village credit card was not available,

WHEREAS the Village must follow lawful procurement rules, and some expenses will need to be made prior to the normal pre-approval process,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Angel Fire Village Council approves a Resolution 2022-53 to reimburse for actual meal, fuel, and other expenses for deployments to fires in Texas, Washington & FEMA Flood Support (Calf Canyon & Hermits peak fires) to Chris Romo in the amount of \$72.05, Justin Williams \$506.00, meals \$356.11 fuel (Washington Fire) \$348.64 (Texas Fire), Angelo Ledoux \$483.95 (Washington Fire) \$271.82 (Texas Fire), Dylan Friedt \$233.85, and Hunter Whitten \$294.35
