

RESOLUTION 2023-51

VILLAGE OF ANGEL FIRE

PARTICIPATION IN TRANSPORTATION PROJECT FUND (TPF) PROGRAM AND REQUEST FOR MATCH WAIVER ADMINISTERED BY NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR CS RANCH/VALLEY RD

WHEREAS, the Village of Angel Fire and the New Mexico Department of Transportation will enter into an Agreement for the FY 24 TPF Program.

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be \$581,000.00 to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

- a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 95% or \$551,950.00

and

- b. The Village of Angel Fire's proportional matching share shall be 5% or \$29,050.00 if Hardship for Match Waiver is not deemed to be present by Department of Finance and Administration and the Department of Transportation

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$581,000.00

The Village of Angel Fire shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$581,000.00.

WHEREAS, the Village of Angel Fire has a limited tax base, which limits the funding for meeting the proportional matching share; and, a fund exists in the NMDOT appropriated by the New Mexico State Legislature for Public Entities in need of "hardship" match money and (the Village of Angel Fire requests participation in this Match Waiver Program in the amount of \$29,050.00.

Now therefore, be it resolved in official session that the Village of Angel Fire determines, resolves, and orders as follows:


That the project for this TPF Agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.

The Village of Angel Fire incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.

NOW therefore, be it resolved by the Village of Angel Fire to enter into an agreement with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for TPF Project LP40053 (FY 24) for Construction and Construction Management/Testing for final contract documentation, bidding/award, construction, reconstruction, pavement rehabilitation/improvements, drainage improvements, construction management and miscellaneous for the Valley Road/CS Ranch Road intersection within the control of the Village of Angel Fire in Cofax County, New Mexico.
